

## Kenyon Mean Trends as Compared to the NSSE National Cohort

Green cells indicate that the mean difference between Kenyon's students and students at all other NSSE participating institutions was statistically significant and positive; orange that the mean difference was statistically significant and negative; clear cells indicate no statistical significance was found. Comparison data is not available for the 2012 Beta survey. Where question wording changed significantly in the 2012 Beta and 2014 administrations, both questions are displayed.
