The Senate issued a student-wide survey in the effort to solicit student opinions concerning the locations of designated smoking areas on campus. From the survey, it was determined that three areas would best serve the students. These are:

- Olin Library – north side of the building near the bike rack between the library and Gund Gallery.
- Gund Commons – ground level, on the East side of the building facing McBride Field.
- Horvitz Studio Art Building – ground level, south end of the building.

Further discussions will concern actions that will make this transition easier for the students. These actions include but are not limited to:

- providing benches in the smoking designated areas
- marking the areas with signs
- placing ashtrays at least 15 feet from all buildings.

No decision has been reached and we expect there will be further discussion before one is made in order to ensure the success of this policy.
